Proudly overlooking the deep-blue waters of the Gulf of Naples from a rocky promontory, Mezzatorre is Ischia's most stylish destination.

Deriving its name from the unfinished watchtower in which it is located, the hotel is a fresh, restorative escape, as it blends unspoiled nature with healing thermal waters, and sophisticated details with authentically Mediterranean vibes.

THE STORY

An ancient and fascinating history



The structure that houses Mezzatorre Hotel & Thermal Spa has a fascinating history. It was, in fact, an ancient watchtower built between the 16th and 17th century by the Aragonese family, which however was never finished (fittingly the name “Mezzatorre” translates as “Half-Tower”). It was enlarged in the 18th century by the dukes of Rancidello.

In the 1930s, the tower was used as a pension until Luigi Patalano, a distinguished scholar, politician and poet, bought it. Founder of political and cultural magazines, he transformed the property into an active cultural cenacle. In the same park as Mezzatorre, Patalano also built “La Colombaia”, a beautiful villa that was first owned by Baron Fassini, an aristocrat and bon viveur, and then, in the 1950s, by film director Luchino Visconti.

In 2018, the Sciò family came across Mezzatorre, fell in love with it and in 2019, the Pellicano Hotels Group took over its management. Marie-Louise Sciò, CEO & Creative Director of the Group, injected her very own personality into every corner of the property – and transformed it into an exceptional Italian abode that fits right into the Pellicano world.



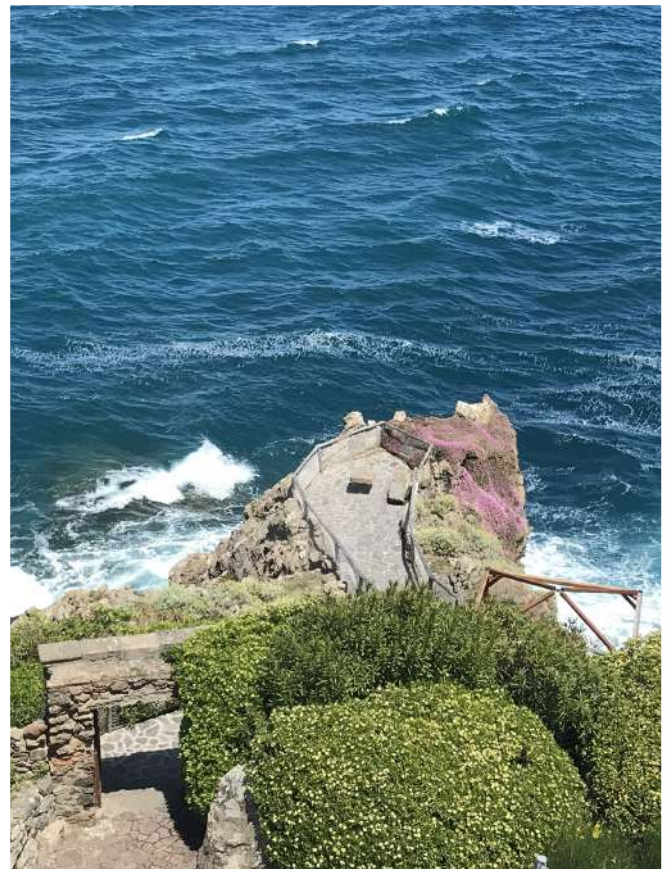
THE DESTINATION

An island of lush greenery and mesmerising wonder

One of the most beautiful islands in Italy and the world, Ischia dazzles visitors with its wild beauty, healing thermal springs, fantastic vineyards and thoroughly Mediterranean vibes. An 18-square-mile island of volcanic tufa and cascading bougainvilleas, craggy rocks and cliffs rearing up over indigo waves, the Green Island, as it's often referred to due to its fertile soil, it is just off the Amalfi coast, and it's easily reachable via ferry or private boat from Naples.

Within its lush, verdant landscape, Mezzatorre overlooks the sparkling Bay of Naples from a secluded location near the village of Lacco Ameno, charming its guests with glorious views and a serene sense of privacy.

The property also makes an excellent base from which to discover the rest of Ischia's many treasures, as well as island hop to Capri and Procida.



ROOMS & SUITES

Stylish boltholes

Mezzatorre welcomes guests in settings like no other. The property's 48 rooms and suites are located either in the old watchtower or in cottages dotted around a seven-hectare park, surrounded by Mediterranean maquis and overlooking the sea.



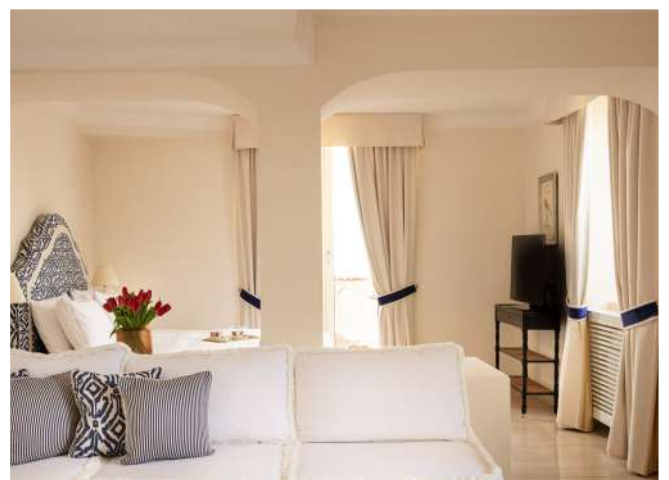
THE GRAND SUITE

An 80 square-metre Suite located in the former 16th-century watchtower; our Grand Suite comes with a large terrace boasting breathtaking views over the Gulf of Naples.



THE BELLEVUE SUITE

A panoramic Suite located on one of the highest floors of the former watchtower. It features a large terrace equipped with sun loungers and umbrellas and offers striking views over the San Montano Bay and the Gulf of Naples.



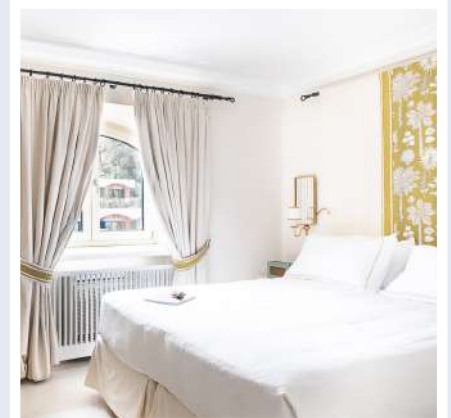
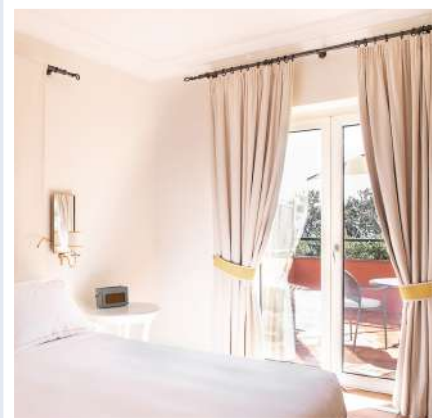


DELUXE SUITES

Located either in the former watchtower or in our cottages, the Deluxe Suites offer stunning views over the sea, generous bedrooms and an open living room with a sofa bed.

JUNIOR SUITES

The Junior Suites are found in the former watchtower and come with pretty views over the hotel's private bay and pool. All Junior Suites feature a bedroom and a separate living room.



DELUXE ROOMS

The Deluxe rooms are located in the watchtower and the cottages. Each one offers a breath-taking view over the San Montano Bay.

Located in the tower and the cottages, these rooms offer a sea view and feature wide windows, small terraces and balconies.

CLASSIC ROOMS

Located in the cottages or in the tower, these elegant rooms offer a partial sea or garden view, through wide windows or semi-private terraces.

RISTORANTE LA TORRE

Using only seasonal produce and the freshest ingredients from land and sea, Ristorante La Torre provides a gastronomic experience that is beautifully balanced between substance and flavour. The tasting menu by Chef Giuseppe D'Abundo showcases true culinary versatility, and features favourites like local snapper, rockfish and seafood. Traditional dishes like “coniglio all’Ischitana” (Ischia-style rabbit) and pennoni pasta with Neapolitan ragout are also a must try. An extensive wine list completes the offerings.



RISTORANTE & BAR LA BAIÀ

Underneath a palapa of giant palm fronds, Ristorante & Bar La Baia puts a spin on seafood and local classics – and boasts one of the prettiest settings on the entire island, as it overlooks the Ischia sea. Snatch up the

catch of the day and try it carpaccio-style or cooked to your wishes; or indulge in a dish of tubettoni pasta with mussels, pumpkin flowers and pecorino cheese.



BAR LA TORRE

Sitting pretty on our terrace, the Bar La Torre is the place to see and be seen in Ischia. Order a Mezzatorre Spritz, watch the sunset over the Gulf of Naples, and embrace the low-key, chill vibes around.

There's more. Spa experiences using mud derived from combining the island's thermal water with volcanic clay work wonders on ailments like respiratory pathologies,

rheumatism, and dermatitis; while natural ingredients and targeted therapies inform all our personalised programmes, which span preventive medicine, anti-ageing treatments and aesthetic solutions.

A highly qualified team of doctors, masseurs, physiotherapists and aesthetic medicine experts is at our guests' service to provide the best assessments and bespoke packages for every individual, as well as bring both tangible physical benefits and lasting inner balance.

There are four cabins for Spa treatments and one for inhalations and aerosols in the Spa pool area. On the ground floor, guests have at their disposal two cabins for massages, two for beauty treatments, one cabin dedicated to manicure and pedicure and an area reserved for osteopathic treatments.

With an outdoor saltwater pool and private deck with access to the sea, plus cushy daybeds and its iconic white-and-blue striped umbrellas, Mezzatorre's Beach Club is the perfect place to laze away the day and enjoy some of the island's most postcard-perfect views.
